Aquajets swimmers excel at Nationals; swim their way into state record books

Rachel Bootsma became the first Aquajet to win a Junior National individual event by swimming a 1:01.71 in the 100-meter backstroke at the Junior Nationals Championships held at the University of Minnesota Aquatic Center on August 4-6. Her time set a Junior Nationals meet record, crushing the previous record held by Olympian Elizabeth Beisel by nearly two seconds. Rachel also bettered her own state record in the event.

Abby Duncan had a phenomenal race in the 100-meter breaststroke, placing fifth overall with an Olympic Trial qualifying time of 1:10.84, and posting a new state record. Van Donkersgoed had a personal best of 2:23.93 in the 200-meter breaststroke, breaking his state record. The 400-meter medley relay team of Katie Bootsma, Duncan, Rachel Bootsma and Emily Blasko finished seventh with a time of 4:19.76, setting a new state record as well. Both Rachel and Abby will qualify to

be members of the U.S. Junior National Swim Team and will travel with the team to compete internationally over the next year.

In only its sixth year, the Eden Prairie-based Aquajets Swim Team has had some tremendous individual and team accomplishments. "We are fortunate to have our own training facility," says Aquajets Head Coach Kate Lundsten. "It has really helped the kids achieve their true potential."

This summer alone, Aquajet swimmers have posted 17 new Minnesota State Long Course records, bringing the team's Long Course record total to 25. 2008 individual records were set by: Bre Thorne in the 9-10 Girls 100-meter freestyle, 100-meter butterfly and 100-meter backstroke; Olivia Anderson in the 11-12 Girls 50-meter breaststroke and 100-meter breaststroke; Van Donkersgoed in the 13-14 Men's 200-meter breaststroke; Rachel Bootsma in the 13-14 Women's 50-meter freestyle, 100-meter

freestyle, 100-meter backstroke, and 200-meter backstroke; Abby Duncan in the 15-16 Women's 100-meter breaststroke and 200-meter breaststroke; and Tess Behrens in the 15-16 Women's 100-meter backstroke and 200-meter backstroke.

Three relay teams also set new state records: the 11-12 Girls 200-meter medley relay of Kira Zubar, Olivia Anderson, Kendal Jacobus and Megan Pohle; the 11-12 Girls 400-meter medley relay of Amelia Schilling, Olivia Anderson, Kendal Jacobus and Kira Zubar; and the Senior 400-meter medley relay of Katie Bootsma, Abby Duncan, Rachel Bootsma and Emily Blasko.
